of the population live on less than \$2.5 AUD a day.



2/3 of Tanzania's children are not in secondary school

Only 30% of secondary school-aged Tanzanians are receiving an education.

97% are not enrolled in further education

Only 3% of Tanzanians aged 17-22 are enrolled in further education.

Our students

We regularly rank in the top 5% in the national exams.

Having an average of only 16 students per teacher helps ensure a great education.

3 St Jude's students have won globally-recognised awards in Science.



Our school

1,800

students currently receive free primary and secondary school scholarships at St Jude's. They benefit from exemplary teaching and facilities, school uniforms, meals, safe transport and a supportive boarding environment.

51%

of our students are female, in a country where historically girls' education is not valued.

An average of **5 people** are supported by each staff member's salary.

St Jude's salaries support and cover school fees for over 500 family members.

Over **\$4 million AUD** is injected into the Arusha economy each year.
