#### Please note

- Educational materials and stationery are always required, especially quality, accurate information and pictures about Africa.
- We have plenty of Australian informational resources, memorabilia, souvenirs, and small clip-on koalas. We do not require any more.
- We cannot use large-sized, stained or heavily worn clothing. It is against Tanzanian law to send or donate used undergarments.







## Second-hand book guidelines
