2. What you need to apply

To be eligible for consideration of your tender suppliers should submit the following:

- Name and postal & physical address of the company
- Name of Director / Owner
- A list of referees' companies that you have supplied in the last twelve months (when supplied, contract value, location of the client and contact details)
- Valid Business license and any other applicable trading licences
- Tax Identification Number (TIN) registration
- TFDA Certificate
- Must be able to provide a Proforma Invoice, Tax Invoice, Delivery Note and legal EFD receipt. The EFD will be verified before the contract is awarded to the successful bidder.
- The cost quoted must cover the transportation, loading, and unloading of the bites to our Sisia campus in Moshono on regular working days, as well as delivery to Smith campus in Usa river and Moivaro campus in Moshono on weekends and public holidays.
- The bidder must bring 1x packet of a sample of the mentioned bites above (**scones, oiled mandazi, baked mandazi & small bread**) well labelled with your company name. You will submit the samples on the tender opening day.
- Tendered price shall be fixed for a contract period of one year.

3. Submission

All Tenders in one original copy, properly filled in, and enclosed in plain envelopes shall be submitted with the necessary documents not later than **15th March 2023 at 10:30am** in a sealed envelope clearly marked
