## About Tanzania

**3/4s** of the population live on less than AU\$4.80 a day.

Over 43 million Tanzanians are living in poverty.

**72%** are not in secondary school.

An adult averages 5.8 years of schooling.

## Our governance >>>>

**AU\$0.97**

of every dollar donated is made available to support the school.



Accounts audited nationally and internationally each year.

Six advisory boards, including four made up of staff, parents and local community representatives involved in decision making.

## Local empowerment >>>>

**350+** local staff, including academic and business leaders. All of our teachers are Tanzanian.

**98%** staff are Tanzanian.

**55** elected parents representing areas students are from, keeping parents informed and strengthening the relationship between the school and the community.
