Interested parties are hereby invited to tender for the supply of the following; "The supply of Beef Meat (chopped), Beef Fillet and Eggs (Kisasa) to The School of St Jude, Sisia Campus, Moshono, Arusha". Bidders are invited to submit their tenders for the supply of the above item.

1. Quantity required

Tenders are invited for the supply of Beef Meat, Beef fillet & Eggs to the School of St Jude, Sisia & Smith, Arusha, Tanzania the following:

- a. *Chopped meat with bones (Meat without intestines, chopped into small pieces ready for cooking × 528kg per month (tentative).*
- b. *Beef fillet 20 kg per month (tentative).*
- c. *Eggs (kisasa), supplied per tray of 30 pieces × 200 trays per month (tentative).*

2. What you need to apply

To qualify for consideration at the eligibility stage, suppliers must submit all of the following documents and information in full.

Please note: Only submissions that provide 100% of the required documents and details listed below will proceed to the next stage (which is specification check, pricing, and then contract).





- i. Name, postal & physical address of the company;
- ii. Name of Director / Owner;
- iii. A list of three Client references to whom you have supplied Beef meat, Beef fillet and eggs in the last twelve (12) months, indicating the date of supply, contract value, client location, and contact details.
- iv. Valid Business license
- v. VAT (if applicable)
- vi. Tax Identification Number (TIN) registration;
- vii. To provide a sample copy of Proforma Invoice
- viii. To provide a sample copy Tax Invoice
- ix. To provide a sample copy Delivery Note
- x. To provide a sample copy legal EFD receipt. The EFD will be verified before the contract is awarded to the successful bidder.
- xi. Bidder to confirm that the meat will be packed in plastic packaging bags (vifungashio), with each bag weighing 5 kg.
- xii. Bidder to confirm that the Beef fillet will be packed in plastic packaging bags (vifungashio), with each bag weighing 2 kg.
- xiii. Bidder to confirm that the eggs will be packed in trays.
- xiv. The bidder to confirm that the tendered price for meat includes *chopping the meat into small pieces ready for use, packing and clearly labelling each pack with the supplier's company name, as well as transportation, loading, and unloading to our Sisia and Smith Campuses (including deliveries on workdays and, when required, public holidays and weekends).*
- xv. The bidder to confirm that the tendered price for eggs includes *transportation, loading, and unloading to our Sisia and Smith Campuses.*
- xvi. The supplier to confirm that, for every 100 kg of meat, 75 kg will be steak and 25 kg or less will be meat with bones.
- xvii. Tendered price shall be fixed for a duration of one year.
- xviii. The tender currency must be Tanzania shillings.
- xix. Bidders may quote for either one or both items. However, bidders quoting for both items are required to submit **separate quotations for Beef meat, Beef fillet and eggs** (In a one sealed envelope).

Please note that all required documents must be arranged sequentially, in the order of items (i) through (xvii).





3. Specifications and conditions

- Meat with bones (chopped ready for use) well packed in a labelled pack with the supplier company name, in every 100kg of mixed meat, 75kg should be steak and 25kg or less should be meat with bones.
- Beef fillet each bag weighing 2 kg.
- Eggs (Kisasa) – white Yolk per tray of 30 pieces egg.

4. Submission

All Tenders in one original, properly filled in, and enclosed in plain envelopes shall be submitted with the necessary documents not later than **Monday 14th September 2026 at 10:30 a.m.** in a sealed envelope clearly marked:

6. Opening of tenders

Tenders will be opened on **Monday 14th September 2026 at 11:00 a.m.** in public. All the Tenderers or their representatives are invited to attend the tender opening ceremony at the School of St Jude, Sisia Campus. Any of the following reasons will lead to disqualification;

- Late submission of tenders as per the given date and time.
- Submission of tenders electronically e.g. email or any other means.

Tenders not submitted on time shall strictly not be considered at the tender opening ceremony nor evaluation, irrespective of the circumstances.

7. Notification of outcome

Bidders shall be notified within 14 days of the tender opening. St Jude's reserves the right to disclose how the outcome was obtained.

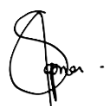
11. Quotations/Evaluation of bids
